Media Committee

A media committee meeting will be held in July. Jon DeMol, Sarah, Jared, Shane, Bryan Rypstra were interested in attending the first brainstorming session for the new year.

Beverage Server Training Discussion – Jon

Jon DeMol reported that each Liquor license – TIPS Certification (good for 3 years)
City of Muskegon identified that the barriers that they encounter are having timely trainings for everyone who needs be trained. Parties in the park, taste in Muskegon (only city limits that they are training)

NSPD sent copy of their ordinance regarding volunteers serving alcohol in community events to the City. It is recommended that everyone attend TIPS training, but should make it required for a certain number of volunteers. The committee discussed that the problem could be solved by having those volunteers know a set date for training "If a training is held every Thursday". Committee decided to not update the PowerPoint, and to continue using TIPS.

Vendor Education/Compliance Checks

Every represented agencies identified and reported retailers in their jurisdiction that had failed their compliance checks.

Press release – Make sure the wording is saying that police officer agencies are still active in conducting compliance checks. Letters are supposed to be going out after the checks saying ~~congrats. A press release should be sent out every May/June.~~



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Ride with Pride Replication

ALI members met with Fruitport School. Assistant Principal, Rob Rogers stated that the easy part will be getting the students excited and engaged. The hardest part will be locking down the biggest donations. Both Rogers and Rypstra stated that they will need to start looking for a car as soon as possible.

Western Michigan Christian School is interested but are not a PBIS school. Jared does not want to turn them away because they are not PBIS. Fruitport PD thinks that if its promoting positive behavior, that they should be allowed to participate in the Ride with Pride Program.
